PURPOSE: To establish the criteria for disseminating local and state dues for those members who have an official NAHU mailing address in one state but want to belong to a local association in another state.

POLICY: NAHU will allow members to join more than one local or state association.

DUES: An individual member may elect to join a local association in a state other than that designated by their mailing address in the official NAHU records; however, they must pay state dues to the State listed in their official records. They will be officially listed as a Member-At-Large (MAL) in their state of record. NAHU will code the respective association to ensure proper distribution of membership dues.

MEMBERSHIP ACCOUNTING: A member with a dual membership will be officially accounted for in the state of official record.

HOUSE OF DELEGATES: Individuals with a dual membership will be counted for voting purposes as follows:

1. as a member of the total state count in the state of official record, and
2. as a member of the local association.

Individuals cannot be counted in the state count of the state of the local association.
