Convention Highlights

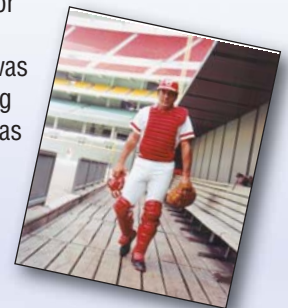
Due to the urgent nature of the comprehensive health care legislation progressing through Congress and the potential changes to our industry, we have added new legislative components to this year's convention. Our keynote speaker on Sunday morning will be **Neal Petersen**, the award-winning author of *Around Alone*. Few people have realized their dreams, but even fewer have raced solo around the world and in a home built boat! It is an unparalleled adventure, the longest, most extreme race for any man or woman, 27,000 miles in a boat, nine months at sea—alone.



Neal has demonstrated what can happen when one truly lives by goals, planning and preparation, believing there are no obstacles so great that they cannot be overcome. In sharing his high-impact extraordinary adventure, Neal delivers a powerful message that, "In life there are no barriers—only solutions." You won't want to miss his inspiring story!

Our keynote speaker on Monday, June 29, will be **Johnny Bench**, star of the Cincinnati Reds, "Big Red Machine." Bench's childhood dream was to become a Major League baseball player, and his father counseled that the position of catcher was the most direct route to that goal. Taking that advice, he became a catcher and was selected in the amateur draft by the Cincinnati Reds. After two seasons in the minors, Bench made Cincinnati's Major League roster for the 1968 season, the beginning of one of the most successful careers in baseball history.



Elected to the Baseball Hall of Fame in January 1989 with the third highest percentage of total votes cast, Bench is undoubtedly the greatest catcher ever. His honors include National League Rookie of the Year (1968), National League Most Valuable Player (1970 & 1972), World Series MVP (1976), 14 All-Star Game appearances and 10 Golden Gloves. He is also the Major League record holder for home runs by a catcher (327), putting him at 21st on the all-time home run list. In 1980, Bench set an endurance record by catching 100 or more games for 13 consecutive seasons. He subsequently spent nine years with CBS broadcasting the National Game of the Week, the All-Star Game and the World Series.
