Description: The William F. Flood Public Service Award is presented to one state or local chapter that excels in public service activities during the period of April 1, 2009, through March 31, 2010. The recommended point threshold for this award is 800 points.

Summary of Criteria:

1. Development of a public service committee.
2. Time commitment to the project per year.
3. Amount of dollars donated for ALL public service activities.
4. Amount of membership involvement.
5. Media awareness and coverage to members and the public.

Directions:

Select a single public service project to present to the Awards Committee. Submit documentation showing that the criteria were met where points are taken.
